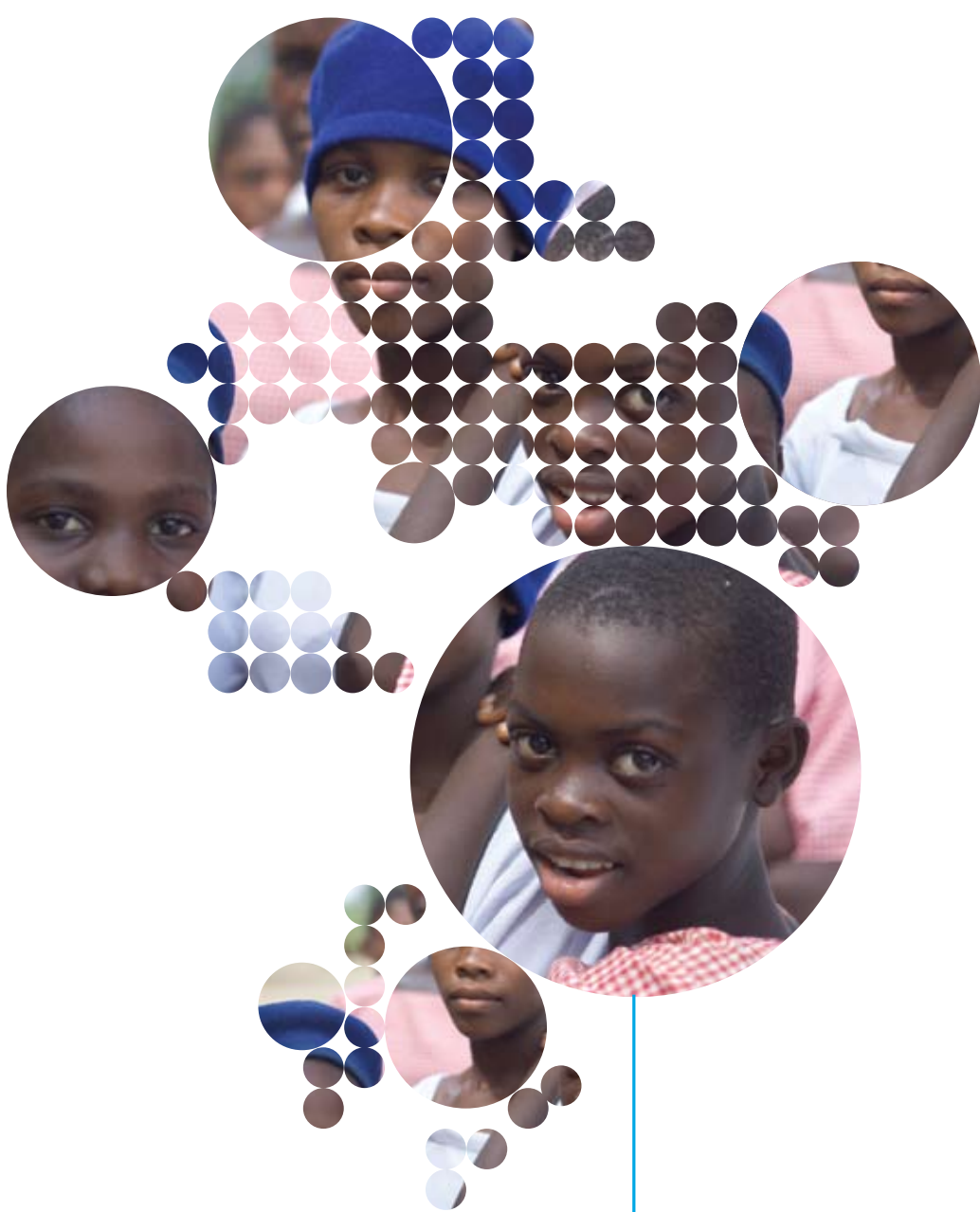

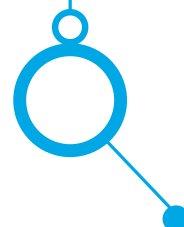
Today, Africa's economies are growing and contributing significantly to the world's energy supply.
